Director D'Orazio worked in the retail industry for 40 years and now runs his own real estate business.

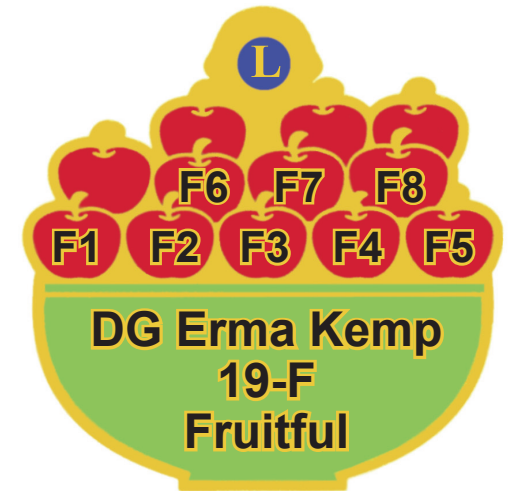
A member of the Boise Beach Lions Club and a Lion since 1980, he has held many offices within the association, including club president, membership chair, district governor and council chair.
